

## USING THE MISSIONARY LIFESTYLE CHART

**First**, fill in your name in the middle of the circle as the missionary. Seeing yourself as a missionary is very important to living like one.

**Second**, fill in the spaces around your name with people in your life whom you could begin sharing the gospel. Think of people at school, neighbors, family members, or people you know from sports. You can even write in people that you might see regularly like the mailman, the person who works at a convenience store, or a clerk at your favorite store.

**Third**, Rate each person's spiritual position.

- 1 – Sees need for Christ in life
- 2 – Seeking God
- 3 – Asks questions about God
- 4 – Interested in spiritual matters
- 5 – Neutral to spiritual matters
- 6 – Actively moving away from God

Then, briefly describe what approach you will take to begin a spiritual conversation.

**Fourth**, be praying for these people. Ask God to soften their hearts and for them to be responsive to the gospel. Pray opportunities to arise and that you will act on them.
